STATEMENT OF THE POLITICAL COUNCIL OF THE ALBA-TCP ON THE SITUATION IN LIBYA

The Political Council of the Bolivarian Alliance for the Peoples of Our America - TCP shares the global concern over the conflict situation in Libya with the consequent loss of lives and expresses its concern that this sister Arab-African nation reach a sovereign peaceful solution for the armed conflict is taking place there, without foreign interference ensuring this way the territorial integrity of that country.

The Political Council of the ALBA-TCP supports the initiative of peace and union of the President of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, Hugo Chávez, to create a "Humanitarian International Commission for Peace and Integrity of Libya" in order to avoid a military attack by NATO forces and as part of the efforts that international community must do to help the Libyan people.

The ALBA-TCP Political Council categorically rejects any intervention by NATO or any foreign power in Libya, as well as any intent to exploit, in an opportunistic way or smeary media campaign, the tragic situation created to justify a war of conquest on energy and water resources, that are the heritage of the Libyan people and cannot be used to satisfy the greed of the capitalist system.
